Primary now sponsors **Cub Scouting**, and 11-year-old Scouts change to a **Guide Patrol** under the Primary's direction.



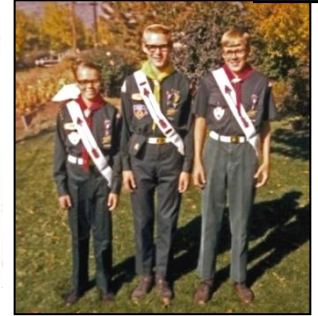
Duty to God Award created for boys 12-18; correlates Scouting and priesthood responsibilities.

'50 Golden Years of Scouting in the Church' celebration held Feb. 1.

Philmont Leadership Conferences for LDS leaders begin June 5-11 1963.



'Recommittal to Scouting' is made by the Church. A **Canada-US Encampment** is held in Farragut, Idaho, in July, with 3500 boys attending.

Guide Patrol Day Camps begin under direction of the Primary.



Webelos rank replaces Lion in an attempt to hold the interest of older Cub Scout boys.



LaVern Parmley, Primary general president, becomes the first woman to serve on a national Scout committee. In 1976, she is the first woman to get the Silver Buffalo Award.

BSA's **career-emphasis Exploring** program now includes girls.

Venturing is created in the Church to meet the needs of young men ages 14-15, who register with the BSA as *Explorers*. Priests, ages 16-18, register as *Ensign Explorers*.

Duty to God Trail Award program begins.



Blazer Patrol replaces the Guide Patrol (11-year-old Scouts) in the Primary in 1970. In 1971, the **New Era** replaces the *Improvement Era*.



M.I.A. is put under the **Presiding Bishopric**.

Then, in 1977 the name is changed to **Young Men** and the Young Men presidency is reinstated.



On My Honor Award for Scouts ages 12-18 is introduced. The Scouting requirements for **Duty to God** are removed in order to accommodate youth living outside the U.S.



Varsity program is developed by LDS leaders in Utah. The 1978 pilot program replaces the Church's Venturing program (boys age 14-15) in 1983 and becomes a National BSA program in 1984.
